I am requesting funding for the **Hawai'i State Emergency Operations Center** in Fiscal Year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the Hawai'i Emergency Management Agency (HI-EMA), located at 3949 Diamond Head Road, Honolulu, Hawai'i 96816.

The funding would be used for design and planning for construction of a hardened and modernized State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) for HI-EMA that will replace the existing Battery Birkhimer SEOC located in the Diamond Head Crater. The Birkhimer facility is a leaking and crumbling 105-year-old armament facility. A new hardened SEOC is desperately needed to support HI-EMA's operational needs. The SEOC will be part of the First Responder Tech Campus (FRTC) in Mililani, Hawai'i. This 244-acre campus is currently programmed to house seventeen Federal, State and County first responder agencies and departments. Building a sustainable, secure, strategically located and centralized SEOC in the FRTC will significantly improve HI-EMA's emergency management and preparedness capabilities.
